"God With Us"

Greetings in the name of Jesus!

I give thanks to God for all of you and the warm welcome that Jen and I have received here! We feel truly blessed by all of you and look forward to getting to know all of you better over the coming years!

As we begin this new leg of our journey together, I am reminded of the call of Samuel (I Samuel 3.1-10). In particular, I have been pondering about how Samuel's first responses to the Lord's call are to do what he knows and thinks is right—he goes to Eli. However, Eli is not the one calling the boy. Eventually, Eli wisely perceives that the Lord is calling the boy and instructs him to simply respond the next time: Speak, Lord, for you servant is listening.

I wonder how often we—as individuals and the church—when we hear the Lord's call go about responding in the ways we know best, in the ways that we think are right. What if God is trying to get our attention? What if God is calling us in a way we haven't heard before? What if we need to stop simply doing what we know how to do and just listen to God?

In this time that is for all of us a new beginning. There is a lot happening in our lives, our church, our community, and the world. It is easy for us to just fall back on what we know, what we are comfortable with and trudge forward. However, I feel that now in this time of transition that we need to take a "Samuel" moment and pause, reflect, and listen. God is speaking to us now in this time and place. God is calling out to us and leading us by God's Holy Spirit. Therefore, my siblings in Christ, I invite you—all of us together—

to pause, to pray, and listen. God, who is trustworthy, is calling. Who knows where the Spirit will lead?

Peace be with you as we listen for God's call.



SUMMARY OF COUNCIL MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 11, 2023

TREASURER'S REPORT: The June Treasurer's Report: General Fund Ending Balance \$21,169.50, Benevolence year to date sent to ELCA \$8,803.20, Capital Improvement \$29,073.90, Checking Account balance \$70,946.50, Savings Account \$103,653.12, ILC Miller Fund \$298,983.26, Property Sales CD \$19,049.58 and Alvin Sommer CD \$12,649.46.

Motion passed to put \$50,000.00 of the Savings Account money into a 9 month certificate of deposit at 5.01%.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Pastor Dan reported that he has met with people who are involved with worship and is making preparations for Worship on Wednesday and Confirmation (aka Faith Formation). He has made two visits to the hospital and three home visits. If there is an urgent need to contact him, send a text or make a telephone call. Otherwise send an email to pas-torbaldwin16@gmail.com. His grandmother's celebration of life services is this weekend and he requested that we keep him in our prayers.

YOUTH AND FAMILY MINISTRY DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Adam announced he would not be able to attend GLOW this Wednesday night because he will be attending his final Foster Parenting Class. He and Pastor Dan have been discussing the youth program. They want to emphasize Faith Formation for the 7th and 8th graders and use the word *confirmation* less because it denotes graduation. They wish to emphasize knowledge about the Ten Commandments, Lord's Prayer, Apostle's Creed, Nicene Creed and the books of the Bible.

They have also been considering offering tutoring to students. Pastor Dan's wife Jennifer Baldwin is willing to come in and tutor students who need help with math or science. Adam is willing to come in and help tutor if other ILC members are also willing to help tutor. English, Social Studies, Humanities, etc could be covered. The tutoring services will be available to all students in the community.

Registration for the 2024 ELCA Youth Gathering in New Orleans is now open. Youth who are in 7th through 12th grade this academic year are eligible.

NEW BUSINESS:

Preparations for the Fall Dinner have begun. Monday is Pastor Dan's day off. Motion passed to change the meeting date of the Boards and Council to the first Thursday of the month.

The council discussed a proposed youth protection policy which would address the protection of those who are vulnerable, especially children and youth. It would also set forth protocol on how the congregation will handle people accused of misconduct. An example of a policy was provided to the council members. The *Youth Protection Policy* has been reviewed and approved by legal authorities and the ELCA, and complies with insurance coverage. The *Youth Protection Policy* covers definitions, transportation of youth, training of community members, screening of Adult Team Members, due process of allegations of misconduct, a Youth Activity Release Form and an Incident Report Form. It was decided to set up a committee from the Youth Ministry Board, the Christian Education Board and the executive. Malissa Kappes, Wendy Johnson, Pastor Dan and Scott Wiley volunteered to be on the committee, to write a policy and to present the proposal one week ahead of the October council meeting.

A new computer is needed. It would be used for teaching children songs that will be sung at WOW, for adult education and for anyone who wishes to move it to where WIFI is available in the church. Two quotes were received. Motion passed to purchase a new computer for \$475.00 from Johnson Accounting.

At the August 13th Semi-Annual Congregation Meeting the motion passed to purchase an Automated External Defibrillator and to place it in an easily accessible location in the church. An EMT coordinator was consulted by Alvin Voyna and he found one for \$1,300.00. It was the consensus of the council that Al should purchase it.

A committee will be organized to set a policy for the use of the church's credit card.

September Minutes Continued

BOARD REPORTS:

<u>Worship & Music</u> – Plans are being made for the installation of Pastor Daniel Baldwin on September 24th. Pastor Steve Bracket of the Northeastern Iowa Synod will be present. Confirmation will be October 29th Reformation Sunday. The community wide ecumenical thanksgiving service will be at First Lutheran this year. All Saints Day will be celebrated on November 12th.

<u>Church Properties</u> – Al Voyna, Gary Ferrie, Bill Seele, and Justin Sovereign and his crew were thanked for their work constructing the new shed and removing the old shed.

<u>Evangelism & Social Concerns</u> – The board is updating its list of shut-ins and who should receive meals.

<u>Christian Education</u> – The availability of the Internet in the rooms, the condition of the furniture and an emergency device in the event of choking is being looked into. One more teacher is needed. Substitutes are needed. Helpers are needed.

<u>Parish Fellowship</u> – The board is planning the dedication ceremony for the Harold Hovey shed and a reception in honor of the installation of Pastor Dan.

Adult Ministry – Pastor Dan has volunteered to lead some Bible studies.

The next board and council meetings are Thursday October 5th starting at 6:30 p.m. Marlene Michel, secretary




